We can offer Dr. Altamirano a salary of about 120,000 Chilean pesos. But as it changes accordingly with the cost of living, I guess that if Dr. Altamirano is coming next year the actual figure shall be much higher. This salary is a good one in money value in Chile, and a family of four can live pretty well with it.

According to a recent letter from Dr. Altamirano he is already engaged in a special research project in Dr. Nachmanson's and can't be free till next year. If he can be here August or September 1956, it would be fine; but I wonder if having that engagement how can he manage to accept your fellowship in teaching.

I am thinking also that maybe Dr. Altamirano would like to bring with him a young physiologist for his staff. We have vacancies for such a person, too.
